Currently the service delivers support through an evidencebased practice known as the 5-step method. Our specialist family support team also aim to allow its service users to partake in interventions which may help them in their day to day lives such as:

- Practicing self-care
- Help increase their knowledge of alcohol and drug use
- Become informed of supports available to their loved ones
- Gain an understanding of how addiction can affect people
- Develop coping mechanisms and how to respond to a loved one's substance use disorder
- Develop their communication skills.
